### **ENERGY: a solar perspective**

As Canada's "sunniest" province, averaging from 2,000 to 2,500 hours of sunshine annually, it would seem that solar energy is an option with much potential for Saskatchewan.

In a well insulated home, passive solar energy can reduce your home heating bill by 30%. Domestic hot water heating is the second biggest energy use of fossil fuel in North American homes and 60 to 70 % of that energy can be eliminated with solar hot water heating.

Solar photovoltaics are utilized throughout the world providing electrical energy for stand-alone and grid connected homes and buildings. Building Integrated Photovoltaics (BIPV) is a huge business in Japan, Spain, Germany and the USA, with solar electric panels directly coupled to the electrical grid.

Germany has increased its solar capacity from 44 megawatts in 2000 to 363 megawatts in 2004, and today is the world leader in manufacturing and utilizing photovoltaics - **55,000 people are employed in the solar thermal and solar photovoltaics industry.**

With over 25 years experience in solar energy, Ken will give us his perspective on Saskatchewan's solar potential ... and a recipe for passive solar design.
